Interrogative Do I have? Have I got? Have you got? Do you have? He He She Have? She got? Does Has lt lt Do we have? Have we got? Have you got? Do you have? Have they got? Do they have?

Example:

Have you got a new phone? Does she have a red car?

Do I have a shower? Has he got a camera?

Do your parents have a boat? Have your parents got a car?
